### Google maps

For a user-friendly app, download google maps to easily track your bus anywhere anytime.



### Discounted Monthly Passes

Eligible low-income families and newcomers can apply for discounted monthly passes through the city of Edmonton. The same application can be considered for leisure access programs (access to participating recreation facilities and attractions).



### Discounted Monthly Passes for Students

From September to June, Edmonton Public School students can check with their schools for discounted monthly passes.



### Family Pass

Family Pass provides unlimited rides for a single day for up to 5 people (maximum of 2 adults over 24 years old and up to 3 children or youth) for only \$10.25.



### ARC

# HOW TO RIDE THE ETS BUS

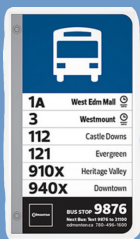
## STEP BY STEP :

Purchase your tickets, passes, or have the exact cash ready to ride the bus.



Arrive at your bus stop at least five minutes early.

Enter the bus through the doors located at the front of the bus.



Show your bus pass to the driver. When paying cash or ticket, put the exact amount or ticket inside the box located on your right as you enter the bus.

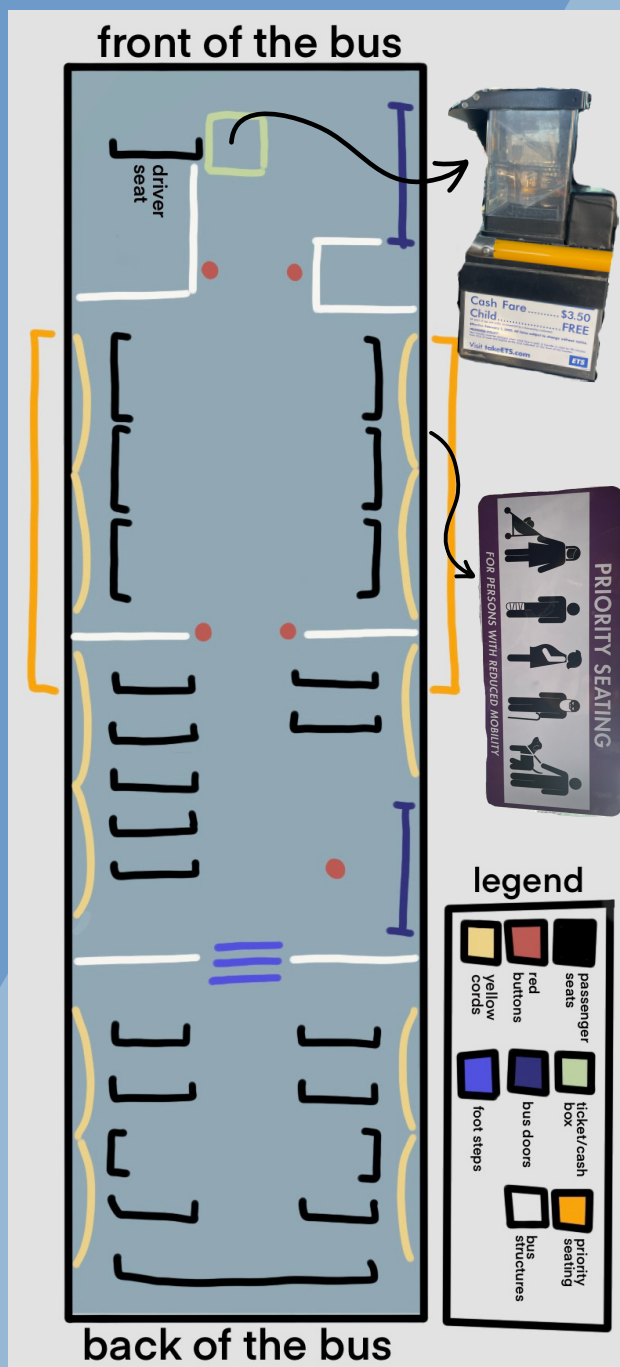


Take an available seat or hold tightly on the poles/handles.

Pull the yellow cord or push the red buttons to let the driver know to stop.

Exit through the back/front doors.

## PURCHASING TICKETS OR PASSES

- **At the Bus:** bills/coins are accepted (\$3.50 per person). Exact amount is recommended. Drivers do not carry change.
- **LRT Stations:** ticket vending machines are available on the platform.
- **Retail Sale Outlets:** many shops like rexall, shoppers, and 7-eleven around Edmonton sell monthly passes and tickets.



- **Online:** visit [shop.edmonton.ca](http://shop.edmonton.ca) to buy the monthly passes & tickets.



### KIDS GO FREE (0-12)

Children are free if they are with a fare-paying person. Children who take the bus alone must pay a cash fare or provide a youth ticket.
